The Sustainable Life Foundation is a non-profit organization, created in 2003. It promotes, participates and informs about socio-environmental matters, environmental communication and education, development and responsible consumption.

**Mision** promoting and developing responsible lifestyles in society within our future on the planet.

**Objective** to promote sustainable lifestyles among citizens to advance in the improvement of people's quality of life and the achievement of a healthier environment.

The **actions** are aligned with the values of **environmental respect**, an active policy in the defense and improvement of human rights, the right to access information, in compliance with labor standards, in environmental management, in the fight against child labor, the fight against all the many forms of corruption and transparency in financial management. To guarantee the execution and monitoring of these criteria, the Foundation is **committed to the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact** and has been preparing progress reports since 2005.

Since 2004, the Sustainable Life Foundation has had a **strategic alliance with the Global Action Plan (GAP) in Spain**, to promote and develop programs to reduce environmental impacts at home, in the office and at school.

Since 2016, has been working to promote the achievement of **Sustainable Development Goals 3, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 17** with projects aimed to promote sustainability.



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Among the projects, we highlight:

- Environmental information publications, such as: Newsletter *Signs of sustainability* and *Ecotopics*, dedicated to the dissemination of environmental solutions for everyday life, production and more sustainable consumption; FVS Responsible Purchasing Guides, a thematic series with information, guidelines and key elements, and recommendations for consumers when purchasing or using a variety of household items, FVS Maps of Environmental Resources and Sustainability Indicators.
- The personal ecological footprint calculator "Calculate the size of your ecological footprint... ¡and learn how to make it smaller!" and four surveys to specifically measure our water, energy, transport and waste footprint.
- The blogs Self-sufficient Citizen, Sustainable People and Homes, and Critical Food.
- The Sustainable Life Foundation Environmental Footprint Seal.



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In 2020 participated as a silent partner, in Erasmus + Projects:

Since 2019, he has also participated as a silent partner of the European Academy Network Project, of the Europe for Citizens Program.

The objective of participating in these projects is to know the European dynamics of projects related to sustainability and education, to begin to formally participate in projects from 2021. The Sustainable Life Foundation already has the profile created, with registration number E10266209.

At the European level, the Sustainable Life Foundation is also a member of the Advisory Council of the ECF4CLIM Project, of the Horizon 2020 Program. In 2018, it also participated in the Big Picnic Horizon 2020 European project, in support of the participation of the Real Botanic Garden Juan Carlos I of the University of Alcalá (Madrid), through the Critical Food Project.

In 2019, the Foundation also participated in a LIFE Project, as a participant, in a working group on Lifestyles, in the event "Adaptation to Climate Change: Society, Education and Lifestyles". This event culminated in the development of a new National Plan for Adaptation to Climate Change (PNACC), for the period 2021-2030.
